

Underwater Hockey at Haverfordwest

Underwater Hockey was played for the first time ever in the County town last week when the Pembroke Club held their first session at the new St Thomas's Green Leisure Centre. The group, which plans to found a new independent club at Haverfordwest, will be at the Leisure Centre Pool on Friday evenings from 8.45-10.00pm with the intention of introducing the game to local swimmers.
